In Paul's letter to the church at Roman Paul was dealing with the same horrors of evil that we are faced with today. The church was being persecuted, not only by the Roman government, but by the Jews who were, in many instances, family and friends. Hear him as he provides guidance through the agency of the Holy Spirit: "Recompense to no man

evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men." Romans 12:17 In other words, you become the best example of how men should behave one to another. You become living proof that doing unto other as you would have them do unto you really is the best course of action. I know what you're thinking, people of color are being mistreated, abused and even killed and you are spouting off about turning the other cheek. Paul knew then as we should know that you don't pour gasoline on a fire to put it out. But he also knew that sometime you have to use a water hose to put out the fire. "If it be possible as much as lieth within you, live peaceably with all men." Sometimes the fight is brought to you and you are left with no choice but to defend, but don't you be on the offensive. "As much as lieth within vou,"

exercise as much restraint as is humanly possible. It won't be easy! If it were everyone could do it. But hear again Paul as he ministers to the church: "Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay saith the Lord." Remember what I said earlier in order to yield the power of goodness effectively you must be able to exercise absolute faith. Give God room to operate, he will fix it!
