## Tough Minds for Tough Times

This is why it is said: <sup>1</sup>

"Wake up, O sleeper,

rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you."<sup>2</sup>

The Psalmist may have phrased it best; Blessed is the man

who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked

or stand in the way of sinners

or sit in the seat of mockers.

2But his delight is in the law of the LORD,

and on his law he meditates day and night.

3He is like a tree planted by streams of water,

which yields its fruit in season

and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers. 3

What the Psalmist is saying to us today is that if you are going to have a Tough Mind for these Tough Times you must understand that the circumspect walk is mindful of not only how to walk, but where to walk. Whether we like it or not, we are defined by the company we keep. I know what you are thinking, wasn't it Paul who said that "we must become all things to all men by all means, that we might save some"? Yes, he did say that and what he meant by that was we must go to wherever the fallen may be and lift up Christ for them to see, but don't get so close that your identity is indistinguishable from Remember he also said " And be not theirs. conformed to this world but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind'. (Romans 12:2)

Please don't think that you can live any kind of way without consequences. Whatsoever a man sews that shall he also reap. If you sew foolishness, you reap foolishness. The Psalmist again says it best:

Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away. 5Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment,

nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous. 4

Nothing good comes from being a fool. One of the little boys that I constantly had to get on about his behavior in class told me: Mr. Thrasher I'm glad that I am the class clown, cause I like to make people
